

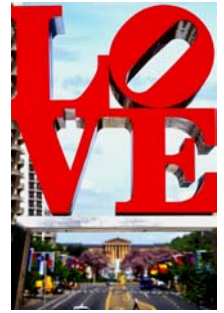
The Philadelphia Story
