

You Too Can Offer CEU's

There are a number of ways that CEU's can be offered online ranging from relatively simple to more sophisticated systems. What can be done depends on content, expertise of web designers involved and, of course, resources to develop and maintain the offerings.

It is very important that anyone thinking of offering sessions verifies that the content of the offerings will satisfy content requirements for CPS CEUs and that required assessment components are included. CEUs must meet the content requirements of improving CPS technical knowledge such as LATCH, a child restraint manufacturer workshop or CPS technical update. Non-technical CPS sessions, such as how to get funding or run an inspection station, do not qualify.

CEU Offerings on cpsboard.org

CEUs by reading *Tech Update*:

1 CEU per certification cycle

- Read 2 issues of the *Tech Update*
- Complete the quiz for both editions and Technicians keep completed quizzes in their files
- Must submit 2 quizzes with at least 4 out of 5 answers correct on each quiz when audited

CEUs by viewing presentations and taking online quizzes:

May earn 1 CEU per certification cycle for passing each online quiz.

To earn 1 CEU

1. Must view or download and read the materials
2. Pass the online quiz for that topic (80%)
3. Certificate of completion with name and certification number is provided for each test passed - must print the certificate of completion at that time - cannot be retrieved later.

NC CPS Conference 2008 Videos

Video sessions from the 2008 North Carolina Child Passenger Safety (CPS) Conference. The videos are divided into two main sections - videos for CEU credits and videos for supplemental information. You do not have to create an account to view any of the videos, but you must create an account or sign in to your existing account to earn CPS CEUs.

After you have signed into your account and viewed an entire CEU-eligible video, you can then take the quiz for that session. In order to pass the quiz, you will need to answer a series of ten multiple choice and true/false questions. If your total score is 80% or higher, you will be able to print out a certificate of completion. Once you have created an account, your progress will be saved and certificates can be retrieved and printed later.
