- Began January 1, 2009
- New 1<sup>st</sup> Offender program, Monitoring Device Driving Permit
- BAIID required
- Administrative Program
- Offender must opt in/opt out, through court system
- No limits on time/place
- 2009, issued approx. 6500

- Educating all entities involved

  - Computer programming
- Offender opt in/opt out....optional program
- Courts not offering program

**Hurdles/Challenges**

- Plenty of time to implement changes
- Terms and Conditions/REPERCUSSIONS
- Computer program for monitoring
- Have full reports sent from vendor to program, rather than vendor reporting violations
- Trained staff to deal with monitor reports/offender explanations/BAIID readings
- Vendor/install site monitoring and certification
- Easy access/fast moving system
- Employment exemption

**MUST HAVES**

- Automate system as much as possible (to track installs, deinstalls, new offenses, failure to respond, etc.)
- Well written admin. Code
  - Which seeks to address all the ins and outs of dealing with DUI offenders
  - Which clearly defines responsibilities of vendors/installers
- Buy-in from every entity in process
- Change in thought and attitude - not same 'punishment' policies

**MUST HAVES**

- Working to update legislation, close loopholes
- Increase participation
- Continue to automate internal processes as much as possible
- Positive reinforcement for those with no violations reported in monitoring period.
